# Dear Friends,

As we remind ourselves every year, Christmas is not a day, it is a season. From December 25 until January 6, we celebrate the incarnation of God in the person of Jesus Christ. After this season ends, the liturgical calendar gives us the season of Epiphany. When I was a child, my parents marked the beginning of epiphany by asking my siblings and me what the word epiphany means. This often led to the snarky reading of a dictionary definition by one of the children. True to this tradition, Webster defines an epiphany as, an appearance or manifestation, especially of a divine being, or an unusual or sudden manifestation or perception of the essential nature or meaning of something.

This year as we move through the Sundays of January and February, we will be using lectionary texts to explore the manifestation of the essential nature of Jesus Christ. The readings that fall between Christmas and Lent describe the revelation of the nature of Emmanuel, God with us, to humanity. As we do so, I invite you to open your eyes to the sudden manifestations of God's presence around you in ordinary and extraordinary ways.


# **2021 Committee Reorganization**
